Being born to a mother who has a blood borne virus	Body piercing or tattooing with un-clean equipment
Helping a bleeding person without using latex gloves	Mixing blood between people
Sexual activity	Sharing needles with another person
Being coughed or sneezed on	Bites from a dog or cat
Bites from insects	Drinking from a water fountain

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Getting a vaccination	Giving blood
Hugging or touching someone	Kissing someone
Shaking hands with someone	Sharing food, cutlery, cups or dishes
Swimming in a public pool	Using a crowded elevator
